Competent person = 'A person with a recognised relevant qualification, sufficient experience in dealing with the type(s) of pollution or land instability, and membership of a relevant professional organisation' - NPPF 2018.



Suitably qualified...

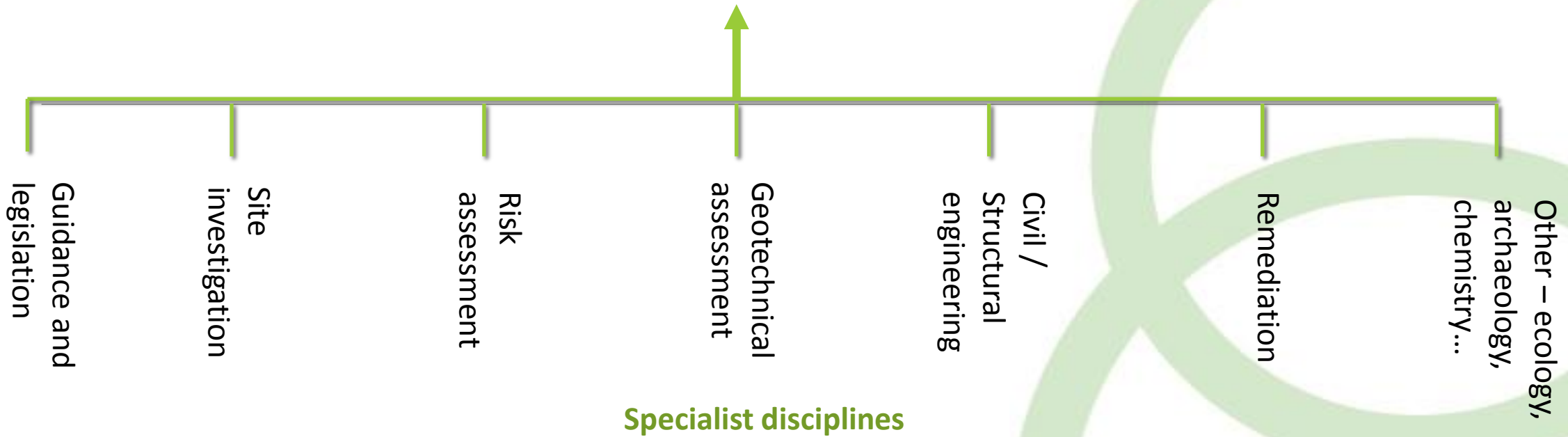
An experienced chartered professional who is bound by a professional code of conduct. They should be of sufficient experience in the sector to have a good overview of the requirements of the various regulatory regimes and of what is required to effectively assess a site and remediate it to a suitable condition; whose judgement can be relied upon with some degree of finality.

Getting to SiLC and SQP

Follow the Brownfield Skills Framework

Capability Level	
1	Aware (1-2 years into career)
2	Basic (2 – 4+ years into career)
3	Proficient – Chartered (from 5 years)
4	Distinguished – SiLC & SQP
5	Expert – ‘a person who is very knowledgeable about or skilful in a particular area’
